Description	<p>Types of projects co-financed :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Toilet seat raiser (€35)• Folding knife and fork (€65)• Bath seat (€160)• Rollator (€200)• Removable and tiltable wheelchair tray (€550)• Walking frame (€600)• Wheelchair cushions (€620)• Lift chair (€1,400)• Shower chair (between €1,500 and €6,000)• Bath stretcher (€3,000)• Adapted car seat (€3,400)• Manual wheelchair (€4,000)• Adapted stroller (€5,000)• Manual wheelchair motor (€6,000)• Adapted communication device (€€8,000)• Electric wheelchair (€8,000)• Specialized wheelchair, active wheelchair, beach wheelchair, all-terrain wheelchair, etc. (€2,500 to €11,500)• Standing lift (€26,000)
Impacts	<p>Families are supported in finding and financing appropriate technical aids to compensate for the limitations experienced by people with leukodystrophy.</p> <p>Essential for facilitating the activities of the person with the illness, technical aids are also useful for caregivers such as family, friends, support professionals, medical or paramedical staff, and school or life assistants.</p> <p>This makes everyday life easier for people with disease and those around them.</p>
